How to Join Rehoboth Baptist Church:

We are always eager to welcome new members into our fellowship. At the close of each worship service, we sing a "song of response." This allows those who are interested to step forward and express a desire to join the church in one of these ways:

- By your profession of faith in Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior followed by believer's baptism by immersion.
- By transfer of membership from another Christian congregation in which you professed your faith and were baptized by immersion.
- By your personal statement of faith, indicating that you have made your personal profession of faith earlier in life and that you were baptized by immersion.

All candidates for membership (after coming forward) are required to attend our First Step class offered each quarter.
